The City's problem runs much deeper than "terrible communications"

Ms. Kovach's May 3 article entitled 'Terrible communication problem' concerning the City's lack of informing its citizens was revealing. Councilor Riel is right to point out the inexcusable lack of respect the City has shown for the local community (and its ward councilors) in its approach to the March 21st drop-in session for Bonnerworth Park.
